By doing this, students are learning employability and carpentry skills to ready themselves for post-secondary training and the work force. The Advanced Construction Technology course has a focus on contributing to the community as part of course content. This project wouldn't be possible without the support of Fries Tallman Lumber, who is donating all necessary materials, and Robinson Residential, who conceptualized and developed the construction plans. Both Fries Tallman and Robinson Residential are partnered with Campus Regina Public on this project, and several other initiatives and programs.



The SEARCH organization has two main objectives; we strive to educate and empower both our clients, but also our post-secondary student volunteers so that they can better serve the community as future health care professionals. “This project is a great example of how business, public education, and the charitable sector can come together to create positive outcomes in the community,” said SEARCH Executive Director, Kelly Husack. “The project is a wonderful opportunity to strengthen these partnerships and include another student group in creating a healthier Regina population.”

SEARCH is a charitable, student-run, interdisciplinary primary health clinic in the North Central community of Regina. Each week at SEARCH, post-secondary student volunteers have the opportunity to work alongside professional mentors to provide clinical services and social programming to community residents. SEARCH

provides an informal, welcoming environment for clients to seek medical treatment, enjoy a healthy meal, receive free childcare, and participate in cultural and educational programming. SEARCH also offers a variety of health-related social programming for all ages that aims to empower individuals to lead healthy lives.
